# FIRE PREVENTION CIRCULAR

---

To All Airport Staff and Partners

### **NO SMOKING AT NON-DESIGNATED SMOKING AREAS IN CHANGI AIRPORT BUILDINGS ADVISORY**

This circular serve to remind all airport staff and partners against smoking in non-designated areas in Changi Airport.

2 Recently, the Airport Emergency Services (AES) attended to a fire incident in Changi Airport originating from a wooden floorboard, caused by dropped light – lighted cigarette butts. Such fire incidents, if not mitigated could cause further property damage and disruption to airport operations.

3 We seek your cooperation to inform your staff and contractors that under the Smoking (Prohibition in Certain Places) Act, it is an offence to smoke at non-designated smoking areas, which includes enclosed areas within Changi Airport and its relevant adjacent areas. Smoking in Changi Airport Buildings is a blatant infringement of the non-designated smoking areas listed under the smoking act. You may refer to the link for more details <https://www.nea.gov.sg/our-services/smoking-prohibition/overview>. Illegal smokers shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.

4 CAG will increase enforcement checks to curb illegal smoking at non-designated areas and our employees will ask any illegal smoker to immediately cease smoking. Under the Act, any person who hinders, obstructs, threatens, abuses, molests or assaults a CAG employee who is carrying out the above function is liable on conviction to a fine of up to \$1,000, a jail term not exceeding 6 months, or both.
